THIS PROGRAM WAS DESIGNED TO AID FAMILIES IN SECURING BABY AND FAMILY CARE ESSENTIALS NOT PROVIDED BY OTHER COMMUNITY AGENCIES TO AT RISK FAMILIES IN MARION COUNTY.

THIS PROGRAM WILL BENEFIT FAMILIES WHO FACE FINANCIAL HARDSHIPS AND IS DESIGNED TO SUPPORT FAMILIES IN TIMES OF AN EMERGENT NEED, THEREFORE RESTRICTIONS WILL APPLY AND AN INTAKE PROCESS WILL BE NECESSARY.

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- MUST BE A MARION COUNTY RESIDENT
- PHOTO ID MUST BE PRESENTED AT EACH VISIT
- CAREGIVER NAME, ADDRESS, PHONE NUMBER REQUIRED
- CAREGIVER EMPLOYMENT STATUS REQUIRED
- CHILD/CHILDREN NAME, AGE, AND DATE OF BIRTH
- PROOF OF CHILD (BIRTH CERTIFICATE, DISCHARGE PAPERWORK FROM HOSPITAL, OTHER PROOF THAT CONTAINS THE CHILD'S DATE OF BIRTH)
- SOCIAL SECURITY CARDS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE])

Product Availability Guidelines Residents will be able to request items once every 30 days while supplies last.

- One pack of diapers (for ages 0-3 years)
- One container of formula (for children ages 0-12 months)
- One baby food pack per child per 30 days (for children 4-12 months)
- Pregnant woman-One pack newborn diapers during their third trimester (must provide proof of pregnancy)
- Other various family essential need items as available
