

## Prevention Tips for COVID-19

- Get the vaccine when it becomes available
- Practice safe social distancing measures
- Thoroughly wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
  - If soap and water are unavailable, use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol content
- Cover your mouth and nose with a cloth face covering when around others
- Avoid touching your face, nose, and eyes
- Clean and disinfect commonly used surfaces

## Signs and Symptoms

- Cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty in breathing
- Fever or chills
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- New loss of taste or smell

## Self-Care Suggestions

The Mayo Clinic suggests...

- Contact your health care provider immediately
- Plenty of rest, fluids, and pain relievers
- Stay home from work and public places, stay isolated even from family at least 5 days after symptoms have started, eat in room with the windows open for fresh air, use a separate bathroom, if possible, clean surfaces touched often, avoid sharing personal items, and stay home for at least 10 days

## COVID Facts for Marion County

\*Data collected from May 31st – June 12th of 2022\*

- ❖ Population: 56,497 residents
- ❖ 16,060 confirmed cases
- ❖ 181 deaths
- ❖ 24 new cases per day (7-day average)
- ❖ 4% testing positive (of those being tested)
- ❖ 1 in 4 residents have been infected since beginning of pandemic
- ❖ The following periods have had the highest infection rates, so far, in Marion County...  
November 2020 – February 2021  
August 2021 – March 2022

## COVID Facts for West Virginia

- ❖ 65% of the population has the 1st dose of the vaccine (1 shot)
- ❖ 58% of the population has the 2nd dose of the vaccine (2 shots)
- ❖ 1,034,259 of the West Virginian population is fully vaccinated
- ❖ 27% of the population has both a booster shot and two doses
- ❖ 1,167,205 doses of the COVID vaccine has been given in WV
- ❖ 475,610 residents have received a booster shot
